### White Wines

- 19 Unoaked Chardonnay, Chamonix, South Africa £44.50  
Intense aroma that recalls ripe apples, lime, and pears with hints of herbs and tropical fruit. Bright and steely dry in flavour, the grapefruit and spice sensations are buoyed by zesty acidity that refreshes the palate.
- 20 Riesling 'Riverbank', Wente, California, USA £47.00  
This Riesling highlights aromas of lime, grapefruit and melon with hints of dried herbs and fresh flowers. The taste is bright and fresh, showcasing flavors of honeydew, mango and Thai basil. The acidity and the sweetness levels are perfectly balanced, creating a full mouthfeel and long, refreshing finish.
- 21 Rioja Blanco, Tobelos, Spain £48.50  
Good intensity of clean ripe citrus fruit, pleasant toasty oak and smoked notes. Dry, light, with balanced fruit and wood assemblage, broadening out on the palate and leaving a lingering refreshing taste of toasty ripe fruit.
- 22 Pouilly Fumé, Domaine du Petit Soumard, Loire, France £55.00  
Smoked aromas and scents of gooseberry and grass. The palate is clean and crisp with notes of white melon, lime and grapefruit.
- 23 Chardonnay, Liberty School, Hope Family, Central Coast, USA £68.00  
Fresh aromas of lemon peel and pear are accented by notes of caramel that add a touch of richness. Bright stone fruit flavours of apricot and nectarine are balanced with a splash of citrus and creamy vanilla undertones.
- 24 Chablis 1er Cru 'Mont de Milieu' - Domaine de Meuliere, Burgundy, France (v) £85.00  
A cool climate Chablis with good minerality. The vines are sixty years old which gives concentration and a lovely aromatic nose. The palate has a beautiful saline mineral quality and a classic fresh acidity.
- 25 Puligny Montrachet, 'Les Noyers Bret' Jean-Marc Pillot, Burgundy, France £124.00  
A dress sewn with gold, shiny and haloed with greenish reflections. Its bouquet combines hawthorn, almond paste, hazelnut, green apple. The lactic aromas of butter, hot croissant and minerals are usual, as well as honey.

## Red Wines

- 39 Rioja Crianza Seleccion, Bodegas Urbina, Rioja, Spain £59.00  
A classic spicy mature Rioja aroma but still with a wealth of fruit. On the palate there is an intensity of stewed autumn fruits, combined with sweet spice. The texture is soft and smooth with a lingering finish. (2000 Vintage)
- 40 Black Nose Red, Les Domaines Rouvinez, Switzerland £59.50  
The nose of blackcurrants and well-ripened strawberries is heightened by a scent of fine, smoky spices. On the palate, it is a rich and concentrated wine that keeps the fineness of its aromas. The finish is long and smooth.
- 41 Clos Laborie, Margaux, Bordeaux, France £69.50  
Notes of black fruits and cooked blackcurrant, with hints of roasted coffee or liquorice. Aromas on the nose suggest black fruits and vanilla, producing a full bodied flavour.
- 42 Malbec, Hermandad, Mendoza, Argentina (v) £74.00  
A full bodied, rich wine revealing deliciously ripe black fruit flavours supported by black cherries and juicy plums, there are also hints of violets and vanilla spice from the time spent in oak; full-bodied with great texture and a long finish.
- 43 Brunello di Montalcino, Tenuta di Sesta, Tuscany, Italy £98.00  
Elegant, rich in scents of mellow red fruits, spicy in notes of liquorice and tobacco. Taste dry, warm, soft with velvety tannins, balanced, very intense, very persistent and elegant.
- 44 Gevrey-Chambertin, Domaine Hermand-Geoffroy, Burgundy, France £125.00  
A more layered if still somewhat fruity nose combines notes of herbal tea, forest floor, red currant and soft wood influence. The mouthfeel of the barely middle weight flavors is finer if not necessarily more concentrated, all wrapped in a mildly austere and tender finish.
